

Directions to the Baseball/Softball diamonds used for the WBLL Father's Day Classic

- 1. WBLL Complex:** East Water Street, West Bend, WI (no address).  
**Directions:** Starting at the intersection of Highway 45 and Highway 33 in West Bend, go east on Hwy 33 for approximately 1.5 miles until you reach Indiana Avenue. Turn right off of 33 and go south on Indiana for about 1/5 of a mile, and then turn left and go east on Water Street until you reach the diamonds.
- 2. Doc Gonring (aka Quaas Creek):** Country Creek Circle, West Bend, WI  
**Directions:** Starting at the intersection of Highway 45 and Highway 33, go east for about 2.5 miles, to River Road (County G). Turn right and go south on River Road for one mile to Decorah (County I). Turn left and go east on Decorah for about ½ mile. Turn left (north) on Country Creek Circle, and look for the entrance to Quaas Creek/Doc Gonring park.
- 3. WB High School:** SE corner of Decorah and River Road, West Bend  
**Directions:** Starting at the intersection of Highway 45 and Highway 33, go east for about 2.5 miles, to River Road (County G). Turn right and go south on River Road for one mile to Decorah (County I). **BOYS:** Turn left and go east on Decorah for about 100 yards, turn right into the parking lot.
- 4. Riverside Park:** Intersection of Kilbourn and Eastern Avenue, West Bend  
**Directions:** Starting at the intersection of Highway 45 and Highway 33 in West Bend, go east on Hwy 33 for approximately 1.5 miles until you reach Indiana Avenue. Turn right off of 33 and go south on Indiana for about ½ mile. Turn left off of Indiana and go east on Kilbourn Avenue for about ¼ mile. The diamond is in the park on the left (where Kilbourn intersects with Eastern Avenue).
- 5. Regner Park:** Intersection of Silverbrook and 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue, West Bend  
**Directions:** Starting at the intersection of Highway 45 and Highway 33 in West Bend, go east on Hwy 33 for approximately 1 mile. Turn left off of Highway 33 and go north on Silverbrook. Silverbrook bends to the east, follow Silverbrook around the bend. The diamond is on Silverbrook where it intersects with 10<sup>th</sup> avenue.
